AFTER THE INTRAVENOUS ANAESTHETIC

1. We strongly recommend that you return home and rest. You are likely to feel tired or sleepy for a few hours. Some patients may even have a short sleep once at home.
2. For the following 24 hours, or until the effects of the sedation wear off, please avoid all activities that require responsibility and/or concentration. This includes, but is not limited to, such activities as:
 - Driving
 - Conducting business
 - Drinking alcohol
 - Housework (including cooking, cleaning, gardening, ironing, etc)
 - Operating machinery
 - Exercise or any other strenuous activity
 - Signing legal documents, or
 - Travelling in a taxi (unless you are accompanied)
3. Please have full regard for any post-operative instructions given to you by your treating doctor or dentist.
